## **Member Spotlight: Ronald Davidson**



Like many other club members, my riding experience began in Mountain Biking. Then around 2000, my friend and teaching colleague, Ray MacAfee rebuilt an old Mercian road bike and gave it to me, with the understanding that I would seriously take up road riding. I made good on the offer, but those skinny little tires and spindly handlebars freaked me out for a long time.

A few years later, I met Joe Hernandez in Spin Class, and he later invited me to join him, Larry Matz, and a few others on a regular Wednesday ride Larry had put together. This group became the core that eventually founded SFCC, with Larry Matz as our first President. I only rode with the group a couple of times, but when the organizational meeting to put SFCC together came along (in 2010) my wife, Michelle, and I were all in. At that time we all got membership cards, and Michelle and I were member numbers 12 and 13.

I joined the SFCC Board in 2011 as Vice President and served for 3 years. During that span, I teamed up with Kathy Welch and others to organize the first-ever SFCC Summer Camp at Grover Hot Springs.

Many of our members may not know that, in those formative years SFCC organized and hosted a Century Ride. My role on the committee turned out to be helping to organize, and then delivering all of the food to the aid stations, which I did with our horse trailer. Now, you may think that delivering food in a horse trailer is not too sanitary! I promise I spent many hours scrubbing the thing out, and all the food was sealed in very pristine plastic boxes! I must have done an ok job, because the next year, our esteemed President Mr. Matz, promoted me to Assistant Ride Director. However, Larry forgot to tell me that our new Ride Director, Betty Bennett was going to Europe, with Hubby Dennis, for 3 weeks just before the scheduled Century. The ride went off well, and I once again delivered food with the horse trailer, but for the second year in a row, our ridership was very sparse. It was decided that the huge work contribution of all of the club members, stacked up against the low ridership did not justify continuing the event, and our century ride faded into history.

Another club event, many members may not be aware of was what we called "Bike Fest". I believe we put this together for 3 years, 2011,12, and 13. I was on the organizational committee for Bikefest 2012 and 13. For these events, we expanded our club BBQ format, to include a kick-off for May is Bike Month, we invited local businesses to set up stalls, and also invited the public to the BBQ. We had our club rides of varying distances, and in addition, a very popular kids' ride, around the park, led by Auburn's Police Chief. The owners of Maki Heating and Air made Olympic Style Medals for all of the participating kids and presented them after the BBQ. The events were well attended by families and friends, we featured the usual delicious BBQ, a fun mixture of "mini business exhibits" added great interest, we got lots of MIBM sign-ups and the kid's ride was a huge hit.

In those early days, I really enjoyed the great camaraderie SFCC offered and decided I would like to contribute a little more. At that time, we did not have many rides on the calendar, so I began to contemplate becoming a ride leader and forming a regular club ride. I developed several routes, got board approval, and with the help of my riding Partner, Tom Parks, launched the Thursday ride from Meadow Vista Park., in January 2012. I dubbed it "The Vista Thursday Ride." I was the only Thursday ride leader, and it remained so for a few years. So after 12 years and 300+ led rides, I'm still at it!

However, since returning from COVID, we now have a stellar group of ride leaders working in a regular rotation, bringing in lots of experience and different approaches, routes, etc. I would like to extend a huge thank you to Carol Maynard, and Jan Van Waaredenberg for taking on a huge leadership role and keeping the Thursday ride rolling when I was down for extended time with medical and traveling stuff. We have a wonderful group of riders on Thursday, hope you will come out and join us. And thanks to SFCC for promoting a fun, safe riding venue for all of us!
